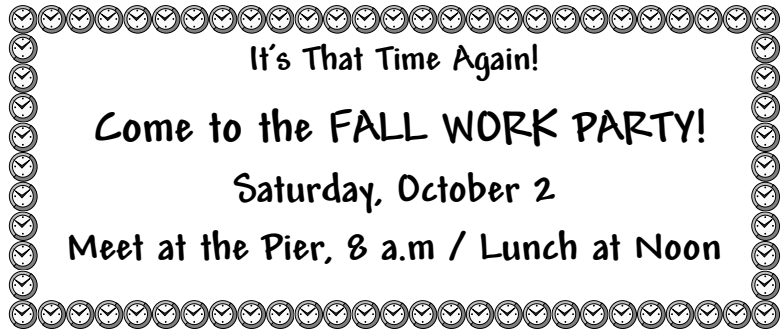

What a summer we’ve had in Loch Haven! The sun has been bright and some of the days have been outright scorchers. But Mother Nature always has the next season in mind. Now kids are back in school and in no time the days will be shorter.

We’ve been relatively lucky in Loch Haven this summer without any major security issues. But there were a few reported incidents of crab pots being emptied out and the traps thrown back onto the owner’s dock. If possible, try to keep your dock areas lit.

Don’t hesitate to call the police to report an incident. The county police use our reports to help gather information involving all local areas, not just our neighborhood. The reports help them pinpoint and notify a targeted area.

A few cars were vandalized this summer as well. The cars were unlocked and the police were notified. The police feel these incidents were perpetrated by people outside our neighborhood, but it is important to keep in mind that anyone has access to the neighborhood. Remember to lock cars, turn on outside lights, and shut garages.

Around the Independence Day holiday, a neighbor discovered an M-150 in her mailbox. Although most likely intended as a harmless prank, explosives can cause serious and permanent injuries. Please be cautious when reaching into dark places such as mailboxes and avoid unsupervised use of explosives.

As always, do not hesitate to contact the Anne Arundel County Police if you have any issues or concerns. The police can be reached at 410-222-1960, but AA County residents are encouraged to dial 911, even for non-emergency issues. I would appreciate knowing about any incidents reported to the police. When using the Beach, please remember to take your trash and leave only footprints.



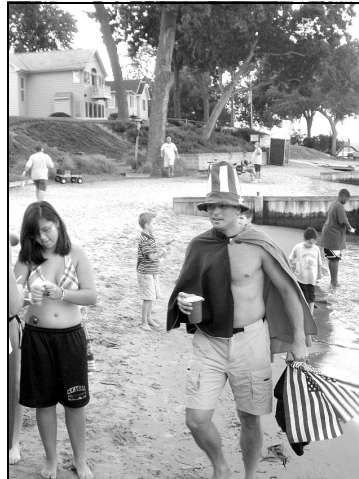
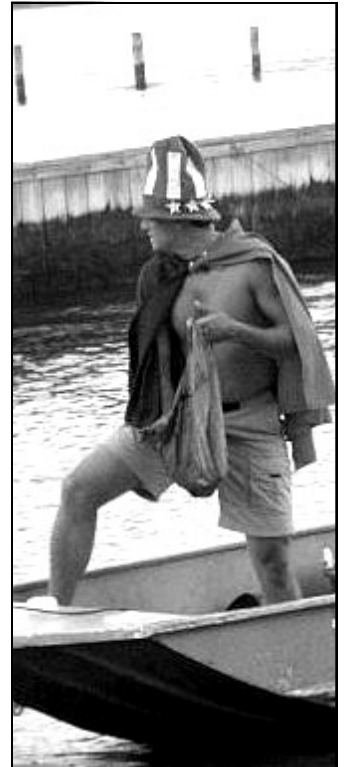
